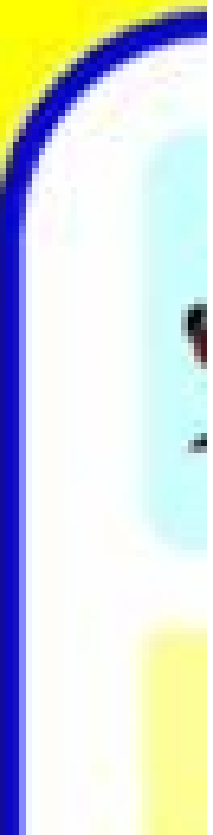

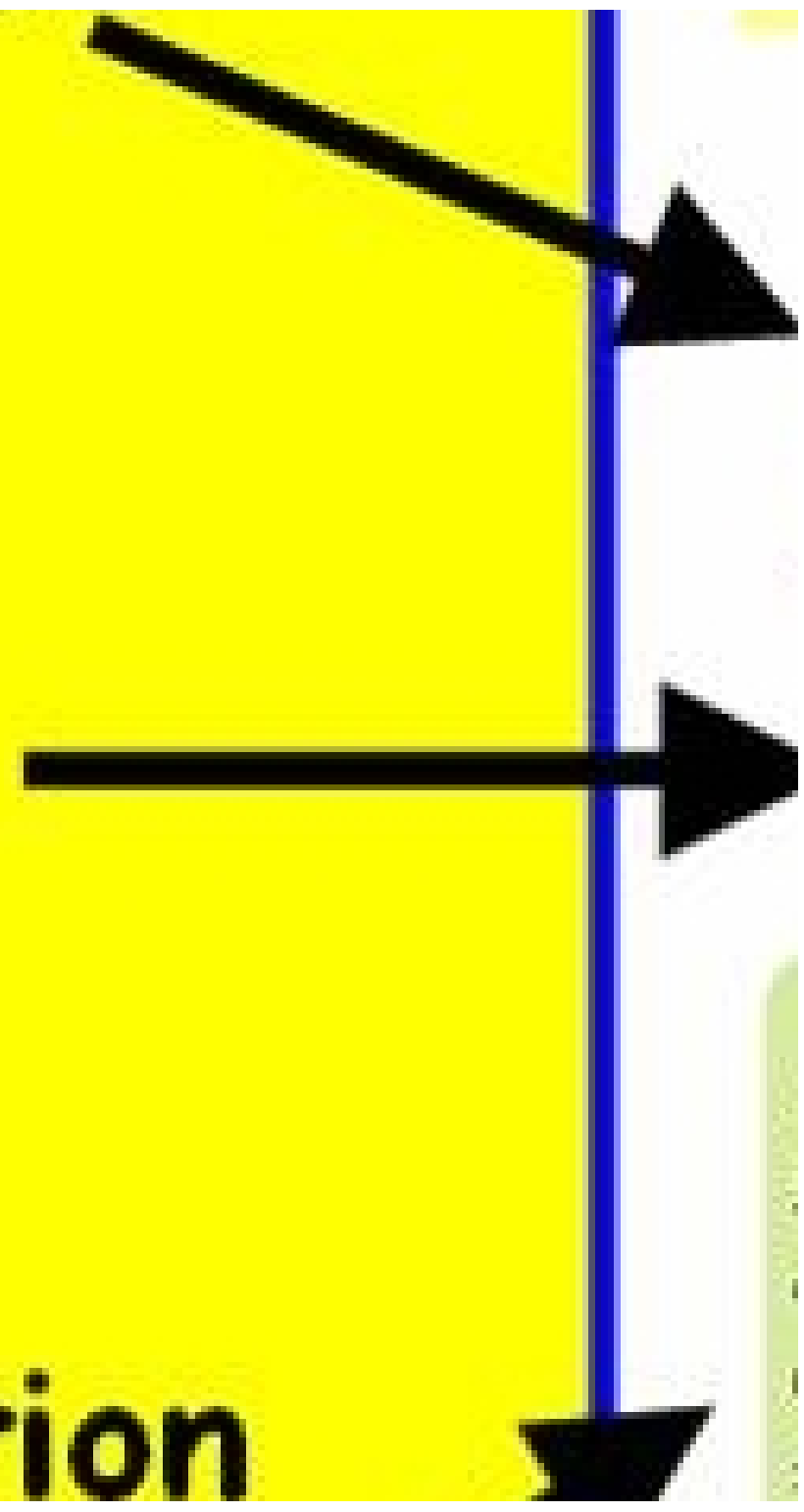

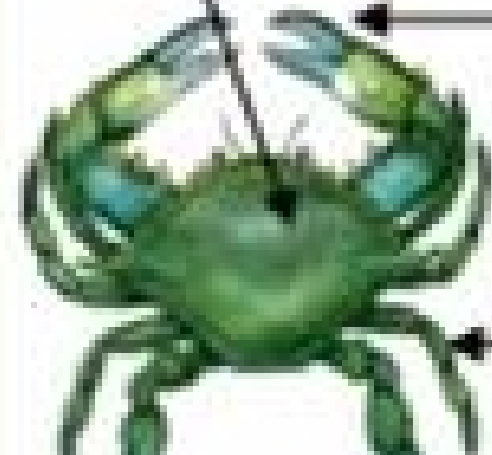
## *A crab's habitat*

Crabs live on the sea shore in rock pools. They have tough shells, but they like to breathe air. Sometimes they hide under stones and sometimes they bury themselves in the sand. Some crabs camouflage themselves by burying themselves in bits of seaweed.

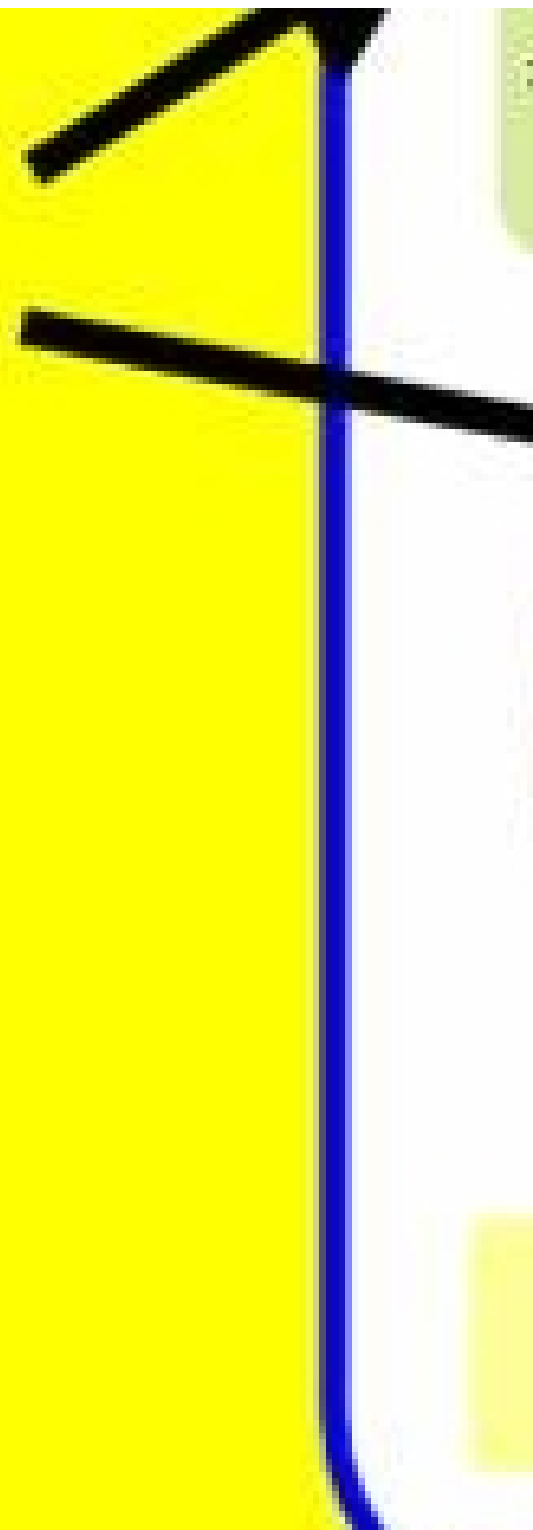

### *Appearance*

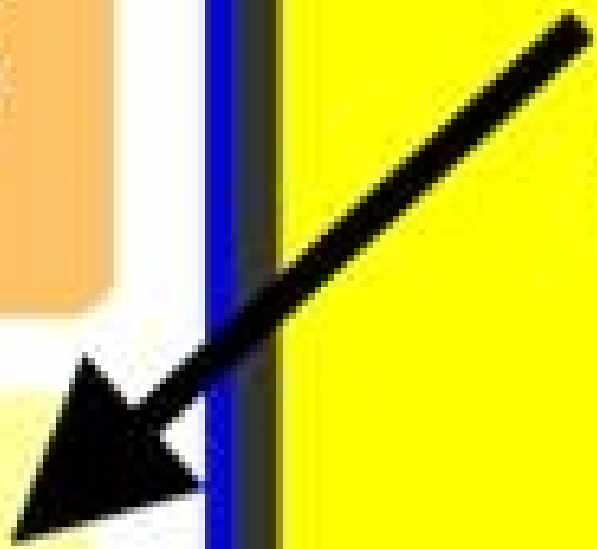
